

Pilgrimage to our Lady of Guadalupe

Mexico City, Mexico – November 11-15, 2019

Day 1 – Mon. Nov. 11, Arrival Mexico City from USA (D)

Depart from St. Anthony of Padua Parish by motorcoach at 4:00am for Newark Airport. Leave Newark on United Airlines flight 1063 at 8:05am with arrival Mexico City at 12:45pm. Time to visit Basilica of our Lady of Guadalupe, Largest Cathedral in the Americas. If time allows, possible visit to La Ciudadela, a market that showcases handcrafts from all over Mexico, to have some time for shopping. Check-in at Galeria Plaza, a first-class centrally located hotel, followed by welcome dinner. *Note: We strongly advise that you carry a snack/lunch to tide you over until dinner at the hotel.*

Day 2 – Tue. Nov. 12, Mexico City (B, D)

After breakfast, head to the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe. Enroute a stop will be made at Tlatelolco, an archeological site well-known for its Plaza of Three Cultures where Pre-Hispanic, Spanish and Mexican cultures converge. Visit the Church of St. James where St. Juan Diego was baptized and where he presented the “tilma” with the image of Our Lady, to the Bishop. Once at the shrine, attend Holy Mass. Later on, there will be time to explore the grounds and to have a closer look at the “tilma”, St. Juan Diego’s cloak, where Our Lady of Guadalupe’s image was imprinted. Later on, depart to visit the Shrine of the Fifth Apparition of Our Lady of Guadalupe which was built upon the ruins of the home of Juan Bernardino, uncle of St. Juan Diego. Dinner will be served either at the hotel or at a local restaurant. Procession on the Tepeyac Hill – 7pm.

Day 3 – Wed. Nov. 13, Mexico City (B, L)

Mass at the Holy Family Church, where you will view the tomb of Fr. Miguel Agustin Pro, the Jesuit martyr. In a time of great religious persecutions, Fr. Pro was exiled from Mexico during the Mexican Revolution. However, he returned to Mexico and was aided by a secret ministry who helped him hide from authorities. During his time in Mexico, he assisted many individuals in their spiritual, as well as temporal, needs. He was eventually discovered, arrested and killed by authorities. While at the Holy Family Church, you may pray to this great martyr who remained filled with the joy of serving Our Lord even in the midst of very difficult times. You will also visit the small but very inspiring Museum dedicated in honor of Father Pro. There will be time for a prayer and a special blessing. Continue the day with a visit to the Plaza of Santo Domingo. This plaza contains two Holy places that are architecturally exquisite; the Church of Santo Domingo, the first church built by the Dominicans in 1576 and; the Shrine of Our Lady of the Rosary, the first Rosary Shrine in Mexico. Additionally, you will visit the Shrine of Our Lady of Covadonga, the headquarters of the Confraternity of the Most Holy Rosary. This Shrine is dedicated to the Patron Saint of Asturias (Spain) Return to Mexico City. Free time this afternoon to enjoy the city, grab a bite before enjoying the Folklore Ballet (Orchestra Floor seating).

Day 4 – Thu. Nov. 14, Tlaxcala (B, L, D)

Departure after breakfast for Tlaxcala where you will visit the Blessed First Martyrs Shrine and the Shrine of San Miguel del Milagro, site of St. Michael’s apparition to Diego Lazaro. Mass will be held at the Shrine of Our Lady of Ocotlan where Our Lady appeared to Juan Diego Bernardino in 1541. After lunch at a local restaurant, the next stop will be in one of the most beautiful open chapels of the country. in time for farewell dinner at the hotel’s restaurant.

Day 5 – Fri. Nov. 15, Mexico City (B)

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for United Airlines flt 1066 at 1:45pm arriving Newark, NJ at 7:30pm. Transfer by motorcoach to St. Anthony Church in Ambler, PA.
